WHO HAS TO REGISTER

Utah Code Annotated, Section 77-41-102 requires registration for offenders who:

- Have been convicted in the State of Utah of any sex or kidnap offense(s) listed in U.C.A. 77-41-102.
- Have been convicted of a crime, or an attempt, solicitation or conspiracy to commit a crime in any other jurisdiction, including any state, federal, or military court that is substantially equivalent to the offenses listed in U.C.A. 77-41-102 (9)(a)(i) thru (iv) and (16)(a)(i) thru (iv).
- Are required to register as an offender in any other jurisdiction, and who are in the state for TEN (10) DAYS within any 12 month period, regardless of whether or not the offender intends to permanently reside in this state.
- Are a nonresident regularly employed, working or a student in this state and were convicted of one or more offenses listed in U.C.A. 77-41-102 (9) and (16) or any substantially equivalent offense in any jurisdiction, or as a result of conviction is required to register in the offender's jurisdiction of residence.
- Have been convicted of, or found not guilty by reason of insanity in this state or in any other jurisdiction, of one or more offenses listed in U.C.A. 77-41-102 (9)(a)(i) thru (iv) and (16)(a)(i) thru (iv).
- Have been adjudicated delinquent based on one or more offenses listed in Subsection U.C.A. 77-41-102 (9)(a)(i) thru (iv) and (16)(a)(i) thru (iv) and who have been committed to the division for secure confinement for that offense and remain in the division's custody 30 days prior to the person's 21st birthday.
- All offenders having a duty to register under Section 77-41-102 are subject to registration requirements in accordance with the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006.
- Jurisdiction means any state, Indian Country, United States Territory, or any property under the jurisdiction of the United States military, Canada, the United Kingdom, Australia, or New Zealand.

WHERE I REGISTER (Per U.C.A. 77-41-105)

- Registration Locations
 - An offender required to register who is under supervision by AP&P shall register in person with the Division of Adult Probation and Parole.
 - An offender required to register who is not under supervision by AP&P shall register in person with the police department or sheriff's office that has jurisdiction over the area where the offender resides (List available on the SONAR website).
- Offenders are required to make notification to:
 - The state or territorial agency in the states where the registrant presently resides and plans to reside when moving across state lines.
 - The out-of-state agency where the offender is living, whether or not the offender is a resident of that state.
 - The out-of-state agency where the offender is a non-resident worker
 - The out-of-state agency where the offender is subject to registration under that state's laws for the time period the offender will be in that state.

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FAILURE TO REGISTER (Per U.C.A. 77-41-107)

- An offender who knowingly fails to register under this chapter or provides false or incomplete information is guilty of:
 - A Third Degree Felony, if the offender is:
Required to register based on a felony conviction; or adjudicated delinquent for what would be a felony conviction if committed by an adult or required to register for the offender's lifetime under U.C.A. 77-41-105 (3)(c).
 - A Class A Misdemeanor, if the offender is:
Required to register based on a misdemeanor conviction or adjudicated delinquent for what would be a misdemeanor if committed by an adult.

WHAT INFORMATION I MUST REGISTER

- An offender shall provide the department or the registering agency with the following:
All names and aliases, the addresses of primary and secondary residences, offender's physical description, vehicle information, current photograph of the offender, fingerprints, DNA, all telephone information, name and Internet address of all websites the offender is registered using an online identifier, including all online identifies used to access those websites (any electronic mail, chat, instant messenger, social networking or similar name used for internet communications except for identifiers used for the offenders employment, financial accounts, including any bank, retirement, or investment accounts) copy of passports and immigration status, all professional licenses, all Utah educational institution affiliations, employment information, all volunteer information and affiliations, and social security number.

WHEN I MUST REGISTER

- Offenders are required to register twice a year, both during the month of the offender's birth and six months thereafter (ie: January and July). Offenders not convicted by the State of Utah must register as if convicted in Utah or more frequently and longer if required by the laws of the state(s) where convicted.
- **Within THREE (3) WORKING DAYS of ANY change in HABITATION (Residence)**
I must provide my physical/residential address where I live to the appropriate agency within three days of any change in habitation as well as any secondary residence or addresses (Secondary residence means any real property the offenders owns or has a financial interest in, OR any location where, in any 12 month period, the offender stays overnight a total of ten or more nights when not staying at the offender's primary residence). This includes adding or changing an address. I understand that being homeless/transient does not release me from my responsibility to register. Post office boxes are only accepted with submission of documentation of physical/residential address. This includes relocation out of the State of Utah.
- **Within THREE (3) WORKING DAYS of ANY change in VEHICLE information, to include:**
The type of vehicle or vehicles the offender owns or regularly operates/drives including: the make, model, color, license plate number, year, and vehicle identification number. This includes work vehicles, regularly driven. A vehicle change includes (but is not limited to) newly purchased or sold vehicles. Vehicles include any motor vehicle, aircraft, or watercraft subject to registration in any jurisdiction.
- **Within THREE (3) WORKING DAYS of ANY change in EDUCATIONAL AFFILIATION Information**
Education institutions include, but are not limited to public or private, primary (elementary, junior high or middle school, high school), trade schools, and secondary (college, university), schools and on-line Schools in Utah.
Affiliations include, but are not limited to on-line or physical presence, carrying on a vocation at a school, enrolled or attending at a school, employed at a school or volunteering at a school.
- **Within THREE (3) WORKING DAYS of ANY change in place of EMPLOYMENT or VOCATION.**
"Employment" or "Vocation" includes employment that is full time or part time, whether financially compensated, volunteer, or for the purpose of government or educational benefit.

FEES

- Each offender shall pay to the State of Utah an annual fee of \$100.00 each year the offender is subject to the registration requirements, during their birth month (unless they are confined in a secure facility or in a state mental hospital).
- Registering agencies may charge up to a \$25.00 per year as a registration fee for those individuals who are not under supervision with Adult Probation and Parole, during their birth month.

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HOW LONG I MUST REGISTER

- Utah convictions: Offenders shall register for TEN (10) years past termination of sentence for the registerable offense, or for the offender's lifetime, depending on the offense.
- Non-Utah convictions: Offenders shall register for TEN (10) years past termination of sentence or longer if required by the sentencing jurisdiction.
- Offenders convicted of U.C.A. 77-27-21.8 shall register for FIVE (5) years.
- In accordance with U.C.A. 77-41-107 an offender shall register for an additional year for every year in which the offender does not comply with the registration requirements of this section.
- Verification of address every 60 days, if offender is subject to a lifetime parole agreement.
- Any registerable conviction dated on or after May 1, 2001, combined with any other registerable conviction (regardless of date), results in a lifetime registration requirement.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Notwithstanding Section 42-1-1, an offender **MAY NOT CHANGE HIS/HER NAME**: while under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections and until the registration requirements under U.C.A. 77-41 have expired, **OR at any time, if the registration requirement is for life.**
- **EXPUNGEMENT** does not relieve an offender from the responsibility to register.
- All offenders having a duty to register under U.C.A. 77-41 need to be aware of and familiarized with possible additional restrictions located at UCA Section 77-27-21.7 and Section 77-27-21.8.
- An offender shall surrender the offender's drivers license, certificate or identification card as required under Subsection 53-3-216(3) or 53-3-807(4) and may apply for a license certificate or identification card as provided under Section 53-3-205 or 53-3-804. A one year driver's license or state ID card is required by all Utah registered sex/kidnap offenders.
- I do hereby certify that I have read the foregoing statements and acknowledge that I understand their provisions and do hereby agree to comply with my registration requirements as outlined in U.C.A. 77-41.
- I have been notified of my responsibility to register as an offender twice a year both in the month of my birth and sixth months thereafter as required by U.C.A. 77-41-105.
- I have been notified of my continuing responsibility to register with the State of Utah at an AP&P office, Sheriff office or Local Police Department within 3 WORKING DAYS of every change in my place of residence (both primary and secondary residence), vehicle information, employment information, and educational information.
- It is my responsibility to register in person and make all of my updates in writing. Updates by phone are not allowed.
- I understand that being homeless/transient does not release me from my responsibility to register.
- I certify I have reviewed the information reported on this offender registration form and it is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
- I understand that providing false or misleading information and/or the omission of requested information may be cause for criminal prosecution and added time on the registry.

I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS FORM IS A SUMMARY OF UTAH SEX/KIDNAP OFFENDER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND I AM REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE LAW REGARDLESS OF THE ABOVE SUMMARY. IF I HAVE ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING MY COMPLIANCE WITH UTAH SEX/KIDNAP OFFENDER REGISTRATION LAWS, I SHOULD READ THE LAW OR CONSULT WITH AN ATTORNEY.
